Greetings!

In the September edition of JADA, Dr. Esther Lopez, DDS, MPH wrote a touching commentary titled "Why representation in dentistry matters." She highlights 2020 data from the ADA Health Policy Institute that showed the racial distribution of dentists nationally was 5.9% Hispanic, 3.8% Black and 18% Asian. This article resonated with me because I am a minority dentist and grew up in a Hispanic neighborhood in Maryland. Witnessing first hand the medical and dental needs of my community shaped my interest in dentistry. In my time as a student at University of Maryland, I easily connected with my patients because I shared a similar background, understood their barriers but I also bridged a communication gap by speaking Spanish. As a community dentist my lived experiences have allowed me to be more empathetic to my patients and also to those who are experiencing trauma. Like Dr. Lopez, I am proud to be a part of organized dentistry but also proud that Maryland is one of four states with a Diversity, Equity, Belonging and Inclusion Committee (DEBI). As a member of DEBI, I am excited to have accepted the position of Vice Chair and look forward to supporting Dr. Francis Morgan who is President. As a woman in dentistry, I have found it important to serve as a mentor. This past year and a half, I was fortunate to welcome three enthusiastic American University pre-dental student volunteers, Batool Chaudhry, Brianna Peng and Kira Carr. They have helped support the office by unpacking supplies, organizing our supply closet, calling patients, and making dental hygiene bags. The benefits have been full circle for me as I have taught them lessons I learned as a dentist, dental student and applicant to dental school. 
* Pre-test for acceptance into radiology course (basic oral anatomy and dental terminology)
